The Rotherhithe Shed Exhibition not only spotlights an awe-inspiring array of handcrafted items produced by the members but it also delves into the heart-warming narratives that intertwine with their creative journeys. "The idea for this exhibition came from our members,' says Lucy Bradshaw, Executive Director at London Bubble Theatre. "We are delighted that we've been able to turn their idea into reality and showcase their talents to a wider audience."

The Rotherhithe Shed Exhibition promises to be an immersive experience that not only showcases the Shed's tangible creations but also captures the intangible bonds formed within these workshops. Visitors will be treated to an array of innovative projects that span across various disciplines. From pedal powered lathes, lamps made out of disused materials, sculpture and carpentry to painting, whittling, woodwork and intricate metal work; the pieces on display embody the essence of passion and purpose that the sheddists pour into their work. Learning and sharing the skills to make, mend and repair is a radical solution to the Age of Waste we find ourselves in and we all have a lot to learn from The Mens' Shed Movement.
